Before we conclude this edition an inspiring comeback story..... Michael Phelps

One of the most decorated Olympian of all time when he announced his retirement following the 2012 Summer Olympics, saying, "I am done. I'm finished. I am retired. I'm done. No more," and "I just wanted to be done with swimming and didn't want anything to do with the sport anymore." However he returned to the pool in 2014 and he staged one of the biggest comebacks in sports history, winning five gold medals and one silver at the 2016 Olympics in Rio de Janeiro. By the end of his career, had won 28 medals, including 23 Olympic golds—the most of any athlete in history.
